

The D-DAY 80th Anniversary Celebration Of 6th June 2024

June 6 marked the 80th anniversary of the D-Day landings along the Normandy coast during World War II. This event, which ultimately led to the liberation of Europe from German Nazism leading to the end of the Second World War in 1945, was commemorated with over 14,000 guests and 170 World War II veterans at the Normandy American Cemetery, with special appearances from U.S. President Joe Biden and French President Emmanuel Macron.
